**Palate Notes:** This elegant wine is lively and high-toned with elevated aromas and character – it really jumps out of the glass. The texture is delightfully silky and supple. As soon as it is in your mouth, it is dancing on your palate. There is real purity of fruit, spicy red fruit, cola, and pomegranate. This wine shows where it was grown – high elevation, plenty of sunshine, very Western Sonoma County, energetic and vibrant. It shows a gorgeous rich color and has fabulous acidity. This wine finishes with an earthy complexity, a pleasing tealeaf, and rich tobacco character.

**Fruit:** Meticulously planted and farmed by Small Vines Viticulture without the use of synthetic chemicals. This single vineyard wine is made entirely from the MK vineyard, which is on a ridge top near the town of Occidental, CA and is owned by the Mat Keller family.

**Spacing:** 4 x4, average yield only 2.5 lbs. per vine

**Clones:** Dijon 115, 114, 667, 777 and 459

**Harvest date:** September 11, 2006

**Winemaking:** Cold soaked 7 days before natural yeast fermentation

**Brix:** Average 24.3

**Barrel Program:** 15 months 43 % new French oak

**Bottled:** December 2007 unfinned and unfiltered

**Alcohol:** 14.3%
